The International Society of Skiing Safety was founded with the primary purpose of providing a forum for discussion and education concerning skiing safety. The Ski Trauma and Ski Safety Congresses have brought together leaders in the fields of medicine, engineering, and snow sports to discuss all aspects of skiing safety. Novel research in the areas of snow sport safety are presented and discussed, including epidemiology, the means to treat snow sport injuries, and how to reduce the likelihood of injury through equipment, education, and area management. Initially the prime subjects of interest revolved around snow skiing, including alpine and cross-country skiing. In recent years the breadth of research has widened considerably, with presentations and discussions regarding snowboarding, freestyle skiing, skiboarding, and other hybrid activities.

Attendees of the Ski Trauma and Ski Safety Congresses have included:

- Medical doctors who work with snow sport injuries
- Engineers from industry, universities, and technical institutions
- Representatives of the skiing industry (such as binding, boot, and ski manufacturers)
- Skiing professionals (such as ski instructors and patrollers)
- Lawyers
- Ski area risk managers and operators
- Participants in recreational and professional skiing and riding activities

Interchange of ideas, comments, and critiques are encouraged in formal discussion of the papers. Many of the individuals who attend these meetings are involved in the American Society of Testing and Materials (ASTM) and International Organization for Standardization (ISO) standards processes. All interested individuals are encouraged to participate.
